Court Ordered Payment Schedule

The defendant has been ordered by the Court to pay **restitution, fine, and/or a special assessment** of \$ 12,727.51, with a remaining balance of \$ 12,387.51. Payment is to be by Certified Check or Money Order and payable to Clerk of the U.S. District Court, 550 W. Fort Street, MSC 039, Boise, ID 83724.

Based upon the probation officer's review of the defendant's financial circumstances, the probation officer has determined the defendant can make payments of at least \$ 50 per month toward their restitution/fine/special assessment obligation.

Upon the probation officer's recommendation, the Court hereby orders the defendant to submit payments of at least \$ 50 per month. Payments are due beginning the 1st of the month following the date of this order and continuing every month thereafter until the obligation is paid in full. This payment schedule will be in effect unless further reviewed by the Court. A review may take place at any time and will be based upon a change in the defendant's financial circumstances.

Waiver of Hearing to Modify Conditions

I have been advised and understand that I am entitled by law to a hearing and assistance of counsel before any unfavorable change may be made in my conditions of **probation or supervised release**. By "assistance of counsel," I understand that I have the right to be represented at the hearing by counsel of my own choosing if I am able to retain counsel. I also understand that I have the right to request the court to appoint counsel to represent me at such a hearing at no cost to myself if I am not able to retain counsel of my own choosing.

I hereby voluntarily waive my statutory right to a hearing and to assistance of counsel. I also agree to the foregoing payment schedule and agree to make monthly payments. I understand that payments which are 60 days past due may result in my return to Court to show cause why my **probation or supervised release** should not be revoked.
